Coronation of the King

It is not too often when something happens that is a once in a life time occurrence. Halley's comet comes around once every 75 years. Last seen in 1986 it is not anticipated to return until 2061. Some may actually get to see it a second time, depending upon the year you were born. I would be 95.

This month we witnessed something that had not been seen in 70 years. I don't know if anyone truly follows the monarchy of the commonwealth of the United Kingdom, yet with the passing of the most renowned monarch of our time, Queen Elizabeth II we had the opportunity to experience the succession that has been anticipated for decades.

Upon her death, Queen Elizabeth's eldest son and next in line to the throne, Prince Charles became King Charles III.

This period was both a time of mourning and a time of celebration. The passing of a beloved Queen that transformed the monarchy not only impacted the nation for which she served, the commonwealth of nations for which she was the figurative head of state but also the world.

During these 10 days of memorial from September 8th through September 17th a pause would occur on September 10th whereby throughout the United Kingdom of Great Britain a proclamation would be made, announcing the reign of King Charles III.

A proclamation is - a public or official announcement, especially one dealing with a matter of great importance.

The same proclamation would be read in England, Wales, Northern Ireland, Scotland and throughout the entire commonwealth of the United Kingdom. From Australia to Canada and all territories in between it would be announced that Prince Charles has acceded to the throne previously held by his mother. Succession occurs immediately upon death.

With each proclamation and thus acceptance of King Charles as the now reigning monarch over the commonwealth canons fired, trumpets sounded and three cheers of hip hip hurrah. God save the King was played as people gathered around to witness now King Charles ascent to the throne.

Though more of a figurehead position, not truly governing, his role, if anything

like that of his mother is to be involved in the affairs of the nations that identify the monarchy.

Once the proclamation was announced, after the mourning period for Queen Elizabeth, the coronation of King Charles would commence. The last time the world witnessed such a coronation was February 6, 1952. For the first time the world would get to witness this assension. Seventy years later we were able to witness the coronation, live and in color. The coronation of Queen Elizabeth will not be experienced any time soon in that the next two inline for the throne are Prince William and his son Prince George.

I share this once in a life time moment with you to share another once in a lifetime moment for which there will be no end. Whether you are alive or dead you will experience so long as you are part of His Kingdom. So long as you are part of the commonwealth, not of the United Kingdom but that of the commonwealth of Israel.

The commonwealth comprises those of the nation and those outside of the nation who have embraced the King of Israel. A commonwealth is an independent country or community, thus there is a connection. Canada is an independent country from Great Britain but part of the commonwealth that recognizes the monarchy as being sovereign. Though at one time it was a ruling monarchy today it is a symbolic monarchy.

You will experience the return and thus the coronation of King Messiah Yeshua as Sha'ul conveys...

1Th 4:13 Now, brothers, we want you to know the truth about those who have died; otherwise, you might become sad the way other people

1Th 4:14 do who have nothing to hope for. For since we believe that Yeshua died and rose again, we also believe that in the same way God, through Yeshua, will take with him those who have died.

1Th 4:15 When we say this, we base it on the Lord's own word: we who remain alive when the Lord comes will certainly not take precedence over those who have died.

1Th 4:16 For the Lord himself will come down from heaven with a rousing cry, with a call from one of the ruling angels, and with God's shofar; those who died united with the Messiah will be the first to rise;

1Th 4:17 then we who are left still alive will be caught up with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air; and thus we will always be with the Lord.

1Th 4:18 So encourage each other with these words.

His appearance is announced through the blowing of the Shofar. The sound of the Shofar has been heard upon the recognition of the King.

King David prepared the people of the nation for the assension of his son Shlomo...

1Ki 1:28 King David answered by saying, "Summon Bat-Sheva to me." She entered the king's presence and stood before the king.

1Ki 1:29 Then the king swore an oath: "As Adonai lives, who has delivered me from all adversity,

1Ki 1:30 as I swore to you by Adonai the God of Isra'el, 'Your son Shlomo will be king after me; he will sit on my throne in my place,' so will I do today."

1Ki 1:31 Bat-Sheva bowed with her face to the ground, prostrating herself to the king, and said, "Let my lord King David live forever."

1Ki 1:32 King David said, "Summon Tzadok the cohen, Natan the prophet and B'nayah the son of Y'hoyada." They came before the king.

1Ki 1:33 The king said to them, "Take with you the servants of your lord, have Shlomo my son ride on my own mule and bring him down to Gichon.

1Ki 1:34 There Tzadok the cohen and Natan the prophet are to anoint him king over Isra'el. Sound the shofar and say, "Long live King Shlomo!"

1Ki 1:35 Then escort him back; he is to come and sit on my throne; for he is to take my place as king. I have appointed him to rule over Isra'el and Y'hudah."

A proclamation was made for Sholmo and a proclamation has been made for Yeshua...

Rev 11:15 The seventh angel sounded his shofar; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the Kingdom of our Lord and his Messiah, and he will rule forever and ever!"

Rev 11:16 The twenty-four elders sitting on their thrones in God's presence fell on their faces and worshipped God,

Rev 11:17 saying, "We thank you, Adonai, God of heaven's armies, the One who is and was, that you have taken your power and have begun to rule.

The sound of the shofar announcing the Kingship of Messiah and His authority over all other Kingdoms and nations.

The throne of David will be occupied once again as Adonai had promised.

Isa 9:5 For a child is born to us, a son is given to us; dominion will rest on his

shoulders, and he will be given the name Pele-Yo`etz El Gibbor Avi-`Ad Sar-Shalom [*Wonder of a Counselor, Mighty God, Father of Eternity, Prince of Peace*],

Isa 9:6 in order to extend the dominion and perpetuate the peace of the throne and kingdom of David, to secure it and sustain it through justice and righteousness henceforth and forever. The zeal of Adonai-Tzva'ot will accomplish this.

Isa 9:7 Adonai sent a word to Ya`akov, and it has fallen on Isra'el.

From the time of His conception Adonai declared and thus confirmed the promise He made to David.

Luk 1:30 The angel said to her, "Don't be afraid, Miryam, for you have found favor with God.

Luk 1:31 Look! You will become pregnant, you will give birth to a son, and you are to name him Yeshua.

Luk 1:32 He will be great, he will be called Son of Ha`Elyon. Adonai, God, will give him the throne of his forefather David;

Luk 1:33 and he will rule the House of Ya`akov forever—there will be no end to his Kingdom."

I am speaking of King Messiah Yeshua.

Natan the prophet speaking to David conveyed the Words of Adonai...

2Sa 7:12 When your days come to an end and you sleep with your ancestors, I will establish one of your descendants to succeed you, one of your own flesh and blood; and I will set up his rulership.

2Sa 7:13 He will build a house for my name, and I will establish his royal throne forever.

2Sa 7:14 I will be a father for him, and he will be a son for me. If he does something wrong, I will punish him with a rod and blows, just as everyone gets punished;

2Sa 7:15 nevertheless, my grace will not leave him, as I took it away from Sha'ul, whom I removed from before you.

2Sa 7:16 Thus your house and your kingdom will be made secure forever before you; your throne will be set up forever.' "

Just as I had conveyed to you a 10 day period leading up to the coronation of King Charles III, there will be a 10 day period upon Yeshua's return and proclamation.

This unique moment in time that all who profess that Yeshua is Lord will experience something quite unique. For the time of Yeshua's return will be a Yovel a Jubilee, whereby another Shofar will sound, not coronating our King, but declaring His Kingship and its impact.

Lev 25:8 " 'You are to count seven Shabbats of years, seven times seven years, that is, forty-nine years.

Lev 25:9 Then, on the tenth day of the seventh month, on Yom-Kippur, you are to sound a blast on the shofar; you are to sound the shofar all through your land;

Lev 25:10 and you are to consecrate the fiftieth year, proclaiming freedom throughout the land to all its inhabitants. It will be a yovel for you; you will return everyone to the land he owns, and everyone is to return to his family.

Luk 4:16 Now when he went to Natzeret, where he had been brought up, on Shabbat he went to the synagogue as usual. He stood up to read,

Luk 4:17 and he was given the scroll of the prophet Yesha`yahu. Unrolling the scroll, he found the place where it was written,

Luk 4:18 "The Spirit of Adonai is upon me; therefore he has anointed me to announce Good News to the poor; he has sent me to proclaim freedom for the imprisoned and renewed sight for the blind, to release those who have been crushed,

Luk 4:19 to proclaim a year of the favor of Adonai."

Luk 4:20 After closing the scroll and returning it to the shammash, he sat down; and the eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fixed on him.

Luk 4:21 He started to speak to them: "Today, as you heard it read, this passage of the Tanakh was fulfilled!"

That was then. Yeshua stopped midsentence conveying that these have been fulfilled now. The passage continues and thus Yeshua will declare upon His return the latter portion that went unread...

...and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn,

Isa 61:3 yes, provide for those in Tziyon who mourn, giving them garlands instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, a cloak of praise instead of a heavy spirit, so that they will be called oaks of righteousness planted by Adonai, in which he takes pride.

Enacting that which the year of Yovel conveys...freedom from the oppression of our transgressions and that of those who have come against us. We are further encouraged upon waiting for our King to return...

Yeshua provided this insight to His talmidim when they inquired further about His statement pertaining to the destruction of the Temple,

Mat 24:3 When he was sitting on the Mount of Olives, the talmidim came to him privately. "Tell us," they said, "when will these things happen? And what will be the sign that you are coming, and that the `olam hazeh is ending?"

Mat 24:4 Yeshua replied: "Watch out! Don't let anyone fool you!

Mat 24:5 For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Messiah!' and they will lead many astray.

Mat 24:6 You will hear the noise of wars nearby and the news of wars far off; see to it that you don't become frightened. Such things must happen, but the end is yet to come.

Mat 24:7 For peoples will fight each other, nations will fight each other, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various parts of the world;

Mat 24:8 all this is but the beginning of the 'birth-pains.'

Mat 24:9 At that time you will be arrested and handed over to be punished and put to death, and all peoples will hate you because of me.

Mat 24:10 At that time many will be trapped into betraying and hating each other,

Mat 24:11 many false prophets will appear and fool many people;

Mat 24:12 and many people's love will grow cold because of increased distance from Torah.

Mat 24:13 But whoever holds out till the end will be delivered.

Mat 24:14 And this Good News about the Kingdom will be announced throughout the whole world as a witness to all the Goyim. It is then that the end will come.

We are witnessing these things occur in our lifetime. He has prepared us for His return, now it is our responsibility to be faithful to what He has instructed us to do...BE HIS WITNESSES.

In the past, I have shared with you some of the signs pointing to His return for which we have not seen yet. Know that His Word has proven time and time again to be true. We wait, anticipating each Yom T'ruah (Rosh Hashanah) "could this be the year", yet we are not to be ignorant of the signs He has revealed to us.

- The Temple

- The two witnesses being killed at the Temple
- Eliyahu the Prophet

All must be witnessed prior to Yeshua's return. Thus we eagerly anticipate His return with each passing Yom T'ruah.

Get yourselves ready for the return and coronation of our King. Whether you are here in this body or awaiting His return in Paradise, be steadfast and thus be reassured that what Messiah Yeshua has said is true.

On this evening others are not anticipating what you are anticipating. Within the Jewish community on this evening it is a beginning of a solumn time, yet for us that solumn time has been transformed into a time of great expectation. Yom Kippur is still extremely important, but not in the manner it will be observed. I will share more about that on Shabbat Shuvah and when we gather for Yom Kippur on the evening of October 4th.
