His promises are written in black and white.

Avraham heard God speak thus He audible heard the Word of God. Hearing the Word of God is powerful and transformative.

When we are in times of struggle and persecution we often question...

There is a movie called "God on Trial" where a Jewish men housed in a concentration camp during World War II start to accuse God and blame Him for what is happening. There were some who did not agree. They put God on trial asking the question..."Where is God?"

Where is God?

Where was He when we were in slavery under the Egyptians?

The same place when He would hear our cries...

Exo 2:23 Sometime during those many years the king of Egypt died, but the people of Isra'el still groaned under the yoke of slavery, and they cried out, and their cry for rescue from slavery came up to God.

Exo 2:24 God heard their groaning, and God remembered his covenant with Avraham, Yitz'chak and Ya`akov.

Exo 2:25 God saw the people of Isra'el, and God acknowledged them.

Where was God when He judged us and expelled us from the land, giving us over to Bavel?

The same place when He told us what would happen after that time of exile...

Jer 29:10 "For here is what Adonai says: 'After Bavel's seventy years are over, I will remember you and fulfill my good promise to you by bringing you back to this place.

Jer 29:11 For I know what plans I have in mind for you,' says Adonai,'plans for well-being, not for bad things; so that you can have hope and a future.

Where was God when we were in exile for some 2000 years?

The same place when He made these promises...

Deu 30:1 "When the time arrives that all these things have come upon you, both the blessing and the curse which I have presented to you; and you are there among the nations to which Adonai your God has driven you; then, at last, you will start thinking about what has happened to you;

Deu 30:2 and you will return to Adonai your God and pay attention to what he has said, which will be exactly what I am ordering you to do today—you and your children, with all your heart and all your being.

Deu 30:3 At that point, Adonai your God will reverse your exile and show you mercy; he will return and gather you from all the peoples to which Adonai your God scattered you.

Deu 30:4 If one of yours was scattered to the far end of the sky, Adonai your God will gather you even from there; he will go there and get you.

Deu 30:5 Adonai your God will bring you back into the land your ancestors possessed, and you will possess it; he will make you prosper there, and you will become even more numerous than your ancestors.

Deu 30:6 Then Adonai your God will circumcise your hearts and the hearts of your children, so that you will love Adonai your God with all your heart and all your being, and thus you will live.

And...

Isa 66:7 Before going into labor, she gave birth; before her pains came, she delivered a male child.

Isa 66:8 Who ever heard of such a thing? Who has ever seen such things? Is a country born in one day? Is a nation brought forth all at once? For as soon as Tziyon went into labor, she brought forth her children.

Isa 66:9 "Would I let the baby break through and not be born?" asks Adonai. "Would I, who cause the birth, shut the womb?" asks your God.

Isa 66:10 Rejoice with Yerushalayim! Be glad with her, all you who love her! Rejoice, rejoice with her, all of you who mourned for her;

Isa 66:11 so that you nurse and are satisfied by her comforting breast, drinking deeply and delighting in the overflow of her glory.

Isa 66:12 For Adonai says, "I will spread shalom over her like a river, and the wealth of nations like a flooding stream; you will nurse and be carried in her arm and cuddled in her lap.

Isa 66:13 Like someone comforted by his mother, I will comfort you; in Yerushalayim you will be comforted."

Isa 66:14 Your heart will rejoice at the sight, your bodies will flourish like newly sprouted grass. It will be known that the hand of Adonai is with his servants; but with his enemies, his fury.

His promises are written in Black and White for us.

He is not done yet. There are more promises He has made that many have not yet embraced. Seek them out, they are written in black and white.

Let us continue to hold on to these promises, even in the midst of challenging times.

Let us Remember Who HE IS...

Exo 34:6 Adonai passed before him and proclaimed: "YUD-HEH-VAV-HEH!!! Yud-Heh-Vav-Heh (י ה ו ה) [*Adonai*] is God, merciful and compassionate, slow to anger, rich in grace and truth;

Exo 34:7 showing grace to the thousandth generation, forgiving offenses, crimes and sins; yet not exonerating the guilty, but causing the negative effects of the parents' offenses to be experienced by their children and grandchildren, and even by the third and fourth generations."

Moshe's response...

Exo 34:8 At once Moshe bowed his head to the ground, prostrated himself

Exo 34:9 and said, "If I have now found favor in your view, Adonai, then please let Adonai go with us, even though they are a stiffnecked people; and pardon our offenses and our sin; and take us as your possession."

We are to humble ourselves before Him. Profess to Him. Trust in Him.

Seek Him and His Promises.

Num 23:19 "God is not a human who lies or a mortal who changes his mind. When he

says something, he will do it; when he makes a promise, he will fulfill it.

The Promise Maker is the Promise Keeper.
