There is a stirring going on amongst the nations that is shaking the very fabric of the world and the body of Messiah.

The stirring is in response to October 7<sup>th</sup> and Israel. There is a side to be taken and we have seen the division starting to occur on a new level then before. The war is a means for proliferating those positions.

We are seeing a stark and sobering contrast in position

Isa 5:20 Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who change darkness into light and light into darkness, who change bitter into sweet and sweet into bitter!

People emboldened to support the atrocities that have occurred calling them justified because Israel is occupying the land. A few weeks ago I shared with you the reality of the people and the land both from Scripture, Adonai as witness and as a result of the fall of the Ottoman Empire in World War I and the events that led to May 14, 1948 when another passage of Isaiah came to fruition...

**Isa 66:7** Before going into labor, she gave birth; before her pains came, she delivered a male child.

Isa 66:8 Who ever heard of such a thing? Who has ever seen such things? Is a country born in one day? Is a nation brought forth all at once? For as soon as Tziyon went into labor, she brought forth her children.

Isa 66:9 "Would I let the baby break through and not be born?" asks Adonai. "Would I, who cause the birth, shut the womb?" asks your God.

Yet we are also seeing justification as well...

"Well we support the Palestinian people not Hamas", when it was the people who elected them as their leaders.

And yet, the proliferation of anti-semitism is seen in these demonstrations. From the river to the sea is the backdrop. Total destruction is the goal. A few weeks ago I shared with you the origins of this narrative that originates from within the United States and the college campus. Everything I have shared in the past is on line in our sermon section.

Last week I shared with you an opportunity to share with Windham Christian Academy. Hence I see another prophecy coming to the forefront as well. It is this stirring that is occurring as a result of October 7<sup>th</sup> because I originally asked

where are all the people wanting to know about Israel and what is happening.

I have realized that there has been a delayed response. Yet what is happening now is unmistakable. I shared with you how Adonai is gathering His people in a way not just conveyed in Deuteronomy 30...

**Deu 30:1** "When the time arrives that all these things have come upon you, both the blessing and the curse which I have presented to you; and you are there among the nations to which Adonai your God has driven you; then, at last, you will start thinking about what has happened to you;

Deu 30:2 and you will return to Adonai your God and pay attention to what he has said, which will be exactly what I am ordering you to do today—you and your children, with all your heart and all your being.

Deu 30:3 At that point, Adonai your God will reverse your exile and show you mercy; he will return and gather you from all the peoples to which Adonai your God scattered you.

Deu 30:4 If one of yours was scattered to the far end of the sky, Adonai your God will gather you even from there; he will go there and get you.

Deu 30:5 Adonai your God will bring you back into the land your ancestors possessed, and you will possess it; he will make you prosper there, and you will become even more numerous than your ancestors.

Deu 30:6 Then Adonai your God will circumcise your hearts and the hearts of your children, so that you will love Adonai your God with all your heart and all your being, and thus you will live.

But that he is gathering them together in their own congregations. The Messianic Jew once hidden and assimilated into the church is feeling the call to gather with their own people.

Likewise there is a stirring for the non-Jew to come along side the Jewish people in a way that Sha'ul conveyed yet has not been embraced...

**Eph 3:1** It is a consequence of this that I, Sha'ul, am a prisoner of the Messiah Yeshua on behalf of you Gentiles.

Eph 3:2 I assume that you have heard of the work God in his grace has given me to do for your benefit,

Eph 3:3 and that it was by a revelation that this secret plan was made known to me. I have already written about it briefly,

Eph 3:4 and if you read what I have written, you will grasp how I understand this secret plan concerning the Messiah.

Eph 3:5 In past generations it was not made known to mankind, as the Spirit is now revealing it to his emissaries and prophets,

Eph 3:6 that in union with the Messiah and through the Good News the Gentiles were to be joint heirs, a joint body and joint sharers with the Jews in what God has promised.

Coming alongside the Messianic Jew in a new and profound way.

The flow of contact we have been receiving has only been increasing. Adonai is shaking the tree and revealing the hidden fruit that resides

Those that are being stirred are coming forward and seeking to know, to understand...

The prophecy I see coming forward now, yet not in its fullness because it is not in Jerusalem is...

**Zec 8:22** Yes, many peoples and powerful nations will come to consult Adonai-Tzva'ot in Yerushalayim and to ask Adonai's favor.'

Zec 8:23 Adonai-Tzva'ot says, 'When that time comes, ten men will take hold—speaking all the languages of the nations—will grab hold of the cloak of a Jew and say, "We want to go with you, because we have heard that God is with you." ' "

Yet, in order to get there, we must be stirred in the diaspora. In the nations.

I have people asking me questions about what is happening and where we are on God's time line.

**Isa 5:19** They say, "We want God to speed up his work, to hurry it along, so we can see it! We want the Holy One of Isra'el's plan to come true right now, so we can be sure of it!"

You can't speed up what Adonai is doing because He has revealed what things must happen as well. Once he says something, He cannot take it back...

Num 23:19 "God is not a human who lies or a mortal who changes his mind. When he says something, he will do it; when he makes a promise, he will fulfill it.

We are still in Revelation 2 and 3 and have not progressed passed the warnings to the Messianic communities I have shared with you that what is happening is related to Psalm 83...

- **Psa 83:1** [A song. A psalm of Asaf:] God, don't remain silent! Don't stay quiet, God, or still;
- Psa 83:2 because here are your enemies, causing an uproar; those who hate you are raising their heads,
- Psa 83:3 craftily conspiring against your people, consulting together against those you treasure.
- Psa 83:4 They say, "Come, let's wipe them out as a nation; let the name of Isra'el be remembered no more!"
- Psa 83:5 With one mind they plot their schemes; the covenant they have made is against you—
- Psa 83:6 the tents of Edom and the Yishma`elim, Mo'av and the Hagrim,
- Psa 83:7 G'val, `Amon and `Amalek, P'leshet with those living in Tzor; (Selah)
- Psa 83:8 Ashur too is allied with them, to reinforce the descendants of Lot.
- Psa 83:9 Do to them as you did to Midyan, to Sisra and Yavin at Vadi Kishon—
- Psa 83:10 they were destroyed at `Ein-Dor and became manure for the ground.
- Psa 83:11 Make their leaders like `Orev and Ze'ev, all their princes like Zevach and Tzalmuna,
- Psa 83:12 who said, "Let's take possession of God's meadows for ourselves."
- Psa 83:13 My God, make them like whirling dust, like chaff driven by the wind.
- Psa 83:14 Like fire burning up the forest, like a flame that sets the mountains ablaze,
- Psa 83:15 drive them away with your storm, terrify them with your tempest.
- Psa 83:16 Fill their faces with shame, so that they will seek your name, Adonai.
- Psa 83:17 Let them be ashamed and fearful forever; yes, let them perish in disgrace.
- Psa 83:18 Let them know that you alone, whose name is Adonai, are the Most High over all the earth.

This battle and every battle that Israel encounters is that of Adonai. He estalished them to be a nation as promised to Avraham...

- **Gen 12:2** I will make of you a great nation, I will bless you, and I will make your name great; and you are to be a blessing.
- Gen 12:3 I will bless those who bless you, but I will curse anyone who curses

you; and by you all the families of the earth will be blessed."

The Adversary or his minions or man will remove Israel from exisitence, for this is the promise associated with the New Covenant made with Israel...

- **Jer 31:30** "Here, the days are coming," says Adonai, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Isra'el and with the house of Y'hudah.
- Jer 31:31 It will not be like the covenant I made with their fathers on the day I took them by their hand and brought them out of the land of Egypt; because they, for their part, violated my covenant, even though I, for my part, was a husband to them," says Adonai.
- Jer 31:32 "For this is the covenant I will make with the house of Isra'el after those days," says Adonai: "I will put my Torah within them and write it on their hearts; I will be their God, and they will be my people.
- Jer 31:33 No longer will any of them teach his fellow community member or his brother, 'Know Adonai'; for all will know me, from the least of them to the greatest; because I will forgive their wickednesses and remember their sins no more."

The promise followed by a declaration regarding Adonai's heart towards His people...

- Jer 31:34 This is what Adonai says, who gives the sun as light for the day, who ordained the laws for the moon and stars to provide light for the night, who stirs up the sea until its waves roar—Adonai-Tzva'ot is his name:
- Jer 31:35 "If these laws leave my presence," says Adonai, "then the offspring of Isra'el will stop being a nation in my presence forever."
- Jer 31:36 This is what Adonai says: "If the sky above can be measured and the foundations of the earth be fathomed, then I will reject all the offspring of Isra'el for all that they have done," says Adonai.
- Jer 31:37 "Look, the days are coming," says Adonai, "when the city will be rebuilt for Adonai from the Tower of Hanan'el to the Corner Gate.
- Jer 31:38 The measuring line will be stretched straight to Garev Hill, then turn to Go'ah.
- Jer 31:39 The whole valley of corpses and ashes, including all the fields as far as Vadi Kidron, and on to the corner of the Horse Gate to the east, will be separated out for Adonai; it will never be uprooted or destroyed again."

So, we must not look at what is happening now in the land through the eyes of man but through the promises of Adonai.

- **Psa 121:1** [A song of ascents:] If I raise my eyes to the hills, from where will my help come?
- Psa 121:2 My help comes from Adonai, the maker of heaven and earth.
- Psa 121:3 He will not let your foot slip—your guardian is not asleep.
- Psa 121:4 No, the guardian of Isra'el never slumbers or sleeps.
- Psa 121:5 Adonai is your guardian; at your right hand Adonai provides you with shade—
- Psa 121:6 the sun can't strike you during the day or even the moon at night.
- Psa 121:7 Adonai will guard you against all harm; he will guard your life.
- Psa 121:8 Adonai will guard your coming and going from now on and forever.
- **Deu 11:11** But the land you are crossing over to take possession of is a land of hills and valleys, which soaks up water when rain falls from the sky.
- Deu 11:12 It is a land Adonai your God cares for. The eyes of Adonai your God are always on it, from the beginning of the year to the end of the year.
- **Psa 46:1** [For the leader. By the descendants of Korach. On `alamot [high-pitched musical instruments?]. A song:] God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.
- Psa 46:2 Therefore we are unafraid, even if the earth gives way, even if the mountains tumble into the depths of the sea,
- Psa 46:3 even if its waters rage and foam, and mountains shake at its turbulence. (Selah)
- Psa 46:4 There is a river whose streams gladden the city of God, the holy habitation of `Elyon—
- Psa 46:5 God is in the city. It will not be moved—when daybreak comes, God will help it.
- Psa 46:6 Nations were in turmoil, kingdoms were moved; his voice thundered forth, and the earth melted away.
- Psa 46:7 Adonai-Tzva'ot is with us, our fortress, the God of Ya`akov. (Selah)
- Psa 46:8 Come and see the works of Adonai, the astounding deeds he has done on the earth.
- Psa 46:9 To the ends of the earth he makes wars cease—he breaks the bow, snaps the spear, burns the shields in the fire.

Psa 46:10 "Desist, and learn that I am God, supreme over the nations, supreme over the earth."

Psa 46:11 Adonai-Tzva'ot is with us, our fortress, the God of Ya`akov. (Selah)

Believers are recognizing these truths in a new and profound way, seeking to understand, yet not relying on what was once conveyed.

An interesting thing happened on May 14<sup>th</sup> 1948...Israel became a nation.

Yet that profound moment in time did not change the narrative that existed on May 13<sup>th</sup> 1948...what do we do about the promises that God has made to Israel and the Jewish people because they are no longer a nation.

Church theology pertaining to the the church replacing Israel has not changed much since 1948, yet that is about to change now. Because the church is being stirred and provoked to ask questions, to understand prophecy and to come along side the Messianic Jew.

This is the time we are entering into now. Look around the room, the majority of you are not Jewish, and yet there are Jewish people here who have been called out and to be gathered with their people.
