Pre-Brith Hadoshah Reading Blessing

Although not formally recognized by the Jewish community, there are portions of the New Covenant writings that can be related to the Parashah for Torah and Haftorah. Equally, as believers we offer up a blessing to Adonai in relation to the New Covenant that is mediated by our Messiah Yeshua.
