<u>Geebore Adonai – The Might of Adonai</u>

Amidah means to stand and is there referred to as the standing prayer. There are a total of 18 traditional prayers that date back to the 2nd Temple period.

The Geebore is the second of the 18 prayers. This prayer speaks of Adonai's might, of Salvation and of the resurrection of the dead. All aspects are found in Yeshua – King of Israel.

HEBREW:

Me cha-mo-cha ba-al g'vu-rote u-me dow-meh lach, meh-lech may-meet u-m'cha-yeh u-matz-me-ach Yeshua.

V'ne-eh-mahn ah-ta l'ha-cha-yot may-teem.

Ba-ruch a-ta Adonai m'cha-yay ha-may-teem.

ENGLISH:

You O Lord are mighty forever. You raise the dead, You are mighty to save.

You sustain the living with grace, resurrect the dead with abundant mercy, uphold the falling, heal the sick, set free those in bondage, and keep faith with those that sleep in the dust.

Who is like You, Master of mighty deeds, and who can compare to You, King who causes death and restores life, and makes Salvation sprout!

And You are faithful to resurrect the dead.

Blessed are You O Lord, Who resurrects the dead.
