**Introduction:** One Man's Messiah Is Another Man's Anti-Messiah

"Oh mighty lord, I pray to you to hasten the emergence of your last repository, the promised one, that perfect and pure human being, the one that will fill this world with justice and peace"

Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad's speech before the United Nations General Assembly - September 17, 2005

Who is he referring to?

Is it Yeshua?

Perspective is important. Especially

Within Islam, they have their own promised one.

Just as Allah is not the same as Adonai, the Mahdi or 12<sup>th</sup> Imam is not the Jewish Messiah spoken of by the Prophets and fulfilled in the person of Yeshua.

What are Islam's expectations of their coming messiah?

Approximately 95 miles from Tehran, the capital of Iran is a city called Qom, where on the outskirts resides the Jamkaran mosque. At this mosque is a sacred well. The opening of this well is covered by a green-like metal box. The box is there to prevent people from jumping into the well.

When people go to the well, their time is spent there praying and kissing the metal box. Others will write down their prayer requests on a piece of paper and drop them down the well. They are addressed to the Mahdi.

Many believe the Mahdi is actually hiding at the bottom of the well and reading the prayer requests.

Shiite Muslims believe that one day, out that well will emerge their version of an Islamic savior or messiah.

On a daily basis, tens of thousands come through this mosque to say their prayers, but also to pray that one day soon the Mahdi will return.

Where did the Mahdi or 12th imam come from?

According to Ron Cantrell, author of "*The Mahdi: Hijacked Messiah*" the Mahdi descended from the Prophet Muhammad himself, but vanished in the middle of the 9<sup>th</sup> century. Now, more than 1100 years later, Shiites are anxiously anticipating the 12<sup>th</sup> Imam to come back at the end of the age.

Cantrell, further explains, that the Mahdi comes with a promise that he would return and bring Islam to its total fruition as the world's last standing religion.

The Mahdi is a personage that is expected to come on the scene as the Islam messiah.

He is expected to come at the end of time, very much like the return of Yeshua.

However, there are some significant differences between the Messiah of Israel and the Messiah of Islam.

According to a 2012 Pew Research poll, a significant number of Shiite and Sunni Muslims believe the Mahdi will return in their lifetime

- 83% in Afghanistan
- 72% in Iraq
- 67% in Tunisia
- 62% in Malaysia

When extrapolating the percentages to a number, we are talking about 600 million muslims.

Sunnis and Shiites have been at odds with each other for centuries, however they both agree that the earth will eventually become an Islamic world.

However, the Shiites have a particular view of how the end times will play out.

In Shiite eschatology, chaos precedes the return of the Mahdi and marks the end of the age.

This is an apocalyptic time marked by wars, plagues and famines, followed by the Day of Judgment.

Concerning countries like Iran, when you see what their primary beliefs are, it is easier to see the motives behind the actions.

With chaos and world turmoil being a prerequisite for the coming of the Mahdi, one can put the pieces together regarding Iranian actions. They are attempting to hasten the return of the Mahdi.

Ahmadinejad has stated publicly that this chaos he was orchestrating must take place before the Mahdi can come on the scene.

Yeshua provides us with His insight:

**Mat 24:6** You will hear the noise of wars nearby and the news of wars far off; see to it that you don't become frightened. Such things must happen, but the end is yet to come.

Mat 24:7 For peoples will fight each other, nations will fight each other, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various parts of the world;

Mat 24:8 all this is but the beginning of the 'birth-pains.'

Even though Ahmadinejad's second and final term ended in June 2013, the ideology of the 12<sup>th</sup> Imam permeates Iran's ruling mullahs (leaders)

The mix of messianic theology and nuclear weapons as part of Iran's foreign policy is a toxic brew with both regional and global ramifications.

Should Iran be successful, it could cast its nuclear shadow over the region and especially their Sunni rivals like Saudi Arabia, not to mention other Gulf neighbors. It would protect them from any credible military intervention.

Any one of a number of terrorist groups would be emboldened, knowing that their patron had their nuclear back.

While the Mahdi returns to "save humanity", Israel and America must first be destroyed, making room for the Mahdi to make his appearance in Jerusalem.

What is happening is not unexpected.

What is this Day of Adonai?

Zep 1:1 This is the word of Adonai that came to Tz'fanyah the son of Kushi, the son of G'dalyah, the son of Amaryah, the son of Hizkiyah, during the reign of Yoshiyahu the son of Amon, king of Y'hudah:

Zep 1:2 "I will completely sweep away everything off the face of the land," says Adonai.

Zep 1:3 "I will sweep away humans and animals, the birds in the air and the fish in the sea, also the wicked and what makes them stumble; I will wipe humanity off the land," says Adonai.

Zep 1:4 "I will stretch out my hand over Y'hudah and all those living in Yerushalayim. I will wipe every remnant of Ba`al from this place, the idol-serving priests and even their names,

**Zep 1:5** those worshiping heaven's army on the roofs, also those who worship and swear by Adonai but swear by Malkam as well,

- Zep 1:16 a Day of the shofar and battle-cry against the fortified cities and against the high towers [on the city walls].
- Zep 1:17 "I will bring such distress on people that they will grope their way like the blind, because they have sinned against Adonai. Their blood will be poured out like dust and their bowels like dung.
- Zep 1:18 Neither their silver nor their gold will be able to save them. On the day of Adonai's fury, the whole land will be destroyed in the fire of his jealousy. For he will make an end, a horrible end, of all those living in the land."
